REGULATION 21

The Reg 21 is an annual requirement for all persons who work with firearms as well as Security Officers within South Africa.

Pricing Structure (Prices subject to change)

Own Equipment and Own Ammo (includes manual, range fees, assessment, and certificate)	R800
TSASA Equipment + TSASA Ammo	R800 +
HANDGUN: 50 Rounds 9mm To pass a handgun you must hit an A4 page 20 out of 25 times from 7m - 2x. Minimum of 50 rounds is required.	R410
SHOTGUN: 10 Rounds To pass shotgun you must hit 5x A5 plate from 7m - 2x. Minimum of 10 SG rounds is required.	R110
PER RIFLE: 20 Rounds To pass each rifle you must hit an A4 page 10 times twice from 10m - 2x. Minimum of 20 rounds is required.	R160

How Does a Regulation 21 Work?

1. **Receive Your Manual & Safety Lecture** – You'll get a Regulation 21 manual and attend a safety lecture to ensure you understand the process.
2. **Complete the Workbook** – You'll receive a Reg 21 workbook with 50 questions, which you'll complete as an open-book test. A minimum 80% score is required to pass.
3. **Range Assessment** – A TSASA instructor will take you to the shooting range, where you'll complete the required practical exercises with your chosen firearms.
4. **Same-Day Results** – Your scores, recommendations, and certification will be issued on the same day upon successful completion.
